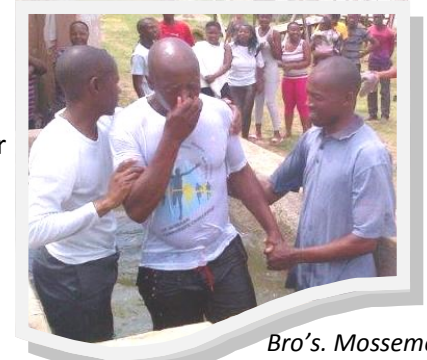

End of year activities dominated the month of December 2014. Pe-school graduation again reminded us of the vital role we continue to have in the lives of under-privileged and marginalized children. Our leadership program culminated their year with all the satellite centers in the Sebokeng joining together at the “Small Farms” center, for the year end graduation. The leader in this area is **Andries Tumahole** who faithfully teaches and leads the congregation in this community. At the close of 2014, **Andries** transported 14 of the people whom he had taught to the IMOM campus to be baptized into our lord. **Br. Mokoena** was there to assist **Andries** as these repentant people confessed their Lord and were added to His body via their water baptism into His death.

As we were going through the certificates of the leaders, someone said, “Wait, the one for brother **James Mbuli** is not needed today.” The sad news was then told to us; the night before our year end celebration a number of men had forced their way into **James’** house and brutally stabbed him to death. No motive has been uncovered. This made



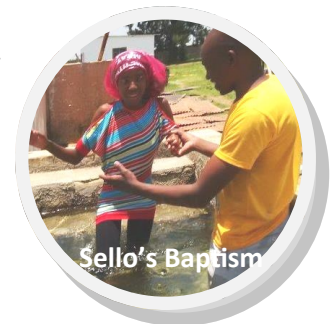
it a bitter/sweet day and reminded us of the urgency there is to train and equip leaders to carry the Gospel message of HOPE that comes only from Jesus **2 Tim.2:2**. A few days later James’ funeral was held and our facilitators were requested to officiate in various parts of the ceremony. James was originally from the ZCC (Zionist Christian Church) and had been methodically sharing and teaching what he was learning with the leaders of this church group.

**MOSEME’S REPORT**

Moseme ended 2014 with a certificate of recognition day. The retired people he has been teaching throughout the year assembled to encourage one another. They had their gathering in one of the mobile teaching tents. About 90% of these senior citizens can only read Sotho. **Moseme** has been translating the **World Bible School** courses into this language as he leads them through these studies. They have requested **Moseme** to continue these studies as they have no such teaching or Bible Studies in their traditional church groups. They are learning much more about God’s grace, mercy and truth, than just the laws of God which are mainly discussed in the other church groups.



In December another TWO of our leader trainees were added to God's family through baptism – the Mosehle's. They also brought two friends to be taught about salvation and Thiipe and Sello were baptized that same day at the IMOM campus.



## **LEADERSHIP TRAINING**

As 2015 gets under way the various satellite training centers start to register new students in the leadership/maturing training courses. The first Wednesday of our training program at IMOM alone, found over 60 students in attendance. Sebokeng preschool has 18 children enrolled, with an expected 35 + by month end. The new **Rustenburg (Lindile, graduate 2007)** and **Ekangala (Ivin)** outreach centers are starting to take shape, and high expectations are held as we have requests for negotiations with the area Chiefs who have shown support for our ministry. General maintenance continues with encouraging progress at the IMOM campus: we have FAITH that this is going to be an awesome year. Thank you all for your partnership in this African ministry – together so much can be achieved for our God and HIS Kingdom.

## **JEFF'S TRAVELS**

Due to requests from the current facilitators and several of the leadership trainees **Jeff** will be travelling to South Africa towards the end of April and the first week of May. Please pray this will be a profitable trip as there are also plans to meet with the Chiefs in the Rustenburg area. Patrick will be travelling to the USA this year towards the end of summer/Fall. More details of his trip will be communicated as soon as we can finalize dates. Some critical needs for 2015 include—3 Mobile tents at \$1075.00 each; \$16,800.00 for annual preschool maintenance and operation; \$2,500.00 p.a. for general Sebokeng campus maintenance; \$7,500.00 p.a. travel funds for Leadership Facilitators (6 facilitators)
