Graduation 2014

God continues to shine HIS love on us regardless of how much sunshine there is. We are blessed in Africa to have warmth and reasonable weather in comparison to the cold been experienced in many parts of the USA. Last year we ended the year with much to be encouraged about. A great graduation of our Leadership classes capping the year off with 56 baptisms on the weekend of graduation. Over 600 souls that we know of were added to the Kingdom of God last year. **Praise The Lord.** After many months of waiting, activity on the

new pre school started late December. Finally we began to see our efforts of becoming more technically efficient in our communication and web site. We had two significant contributions made through our online donation options. These among other accomplishments were great encouragements for all of us. **Thank you for your part in making this happen.**

We still lack \$800.00 to be able to complete the restoration of our office buildings after we lost the roof in a wind storm. In spite of that we continue to host counselling classes and walk-in Bible Studies in the building.



## LEADERSHIP EQUIPPING

After much Prayer, we continue to focus on our Leadership Equipping classes and God continues to Bless our efforts. This year we have FOUR locations with FIVE classes functional. Our sites are Boipatong, Sharpville, Small Farms and two classes at IMOM. At writing we have a total of 176 students enrolled in

these classes. An increase of 47 over our initial enrollment last year. This does not include the Youth leadership classes of Moseme, in Waterdall and Tshepong. These two classes have 42 students enrolled. We Pray that God will provide the finances for these additional opportunities. On average each of these centers cost \$73.00 per month to equip and run, beside the expense of the teachers.

Last year we launched our **Mobile Classroom** concept. We equip a 12x12 tent with 20 chairs and a potable desk and lectern (total current cost as of last month \$976.00 per unit) We place it in an area with one of our active evangelists. Currently we have 3 units in the field and they are proving to be extremely effective tools. As funds are available we are praying that we will be able to place an additional 7 in the field by the end of this year. Please contact Jeff if you would like to sponsor one or more of these units.

An additional training center in Soweto continues to function as a future resource to the other centers. We were blessed with donations of several computers from a local company as they upgraded their office computers. Of all that was donated to us we were able to salvage 5 complete working systems. Our goal is to have this advanced training center fully functional by mid year and be able to offer a degree program through Nations University <http://www.nationsu.org/> from Nashville TN. This is an additional cost to an already stretched budget. More specific information will be given on request and as we become more functional with this training center.

## IMOM PRE-SCHOOL

Over the past year I have reported on the activities and needs for our pre-school. Due to several reasons we were compelled to cut back on our enrollment. As we have done this we have received more and more pressure to reopen our enrolment. The break has given us opportunity to recruit and **train new teachers and leadership**. God has blessed us with this endeavor. We still have financial issues restricting our growth, but we are functioning far more efficiently.

This school has been functional since 2002 and we currently have **30 students in 3 classes**. We do have room to accommodate

another 20 students and the demand is far greater than that. As we had made a choice several years back to expand this area of our work only if the finances were available, we have held its growth in check. In spite of that with increased costs we are still under financed and ask if you know anyone who may be interested in
